

Annual Meeting of Shareholders May 22, 2021 Candidate Information Packet

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2021 ELECTION PROCESS HIGHLIGHTS

- You must be a Class A shareholder 18 years of age or older to run for the Shee Atiká Board.
- You cannot run for the Board if (i) you are an officer or director of another ANCSA corporation; (ii) you are an employee or paid consultant of Shee Atiká, Incorporated or one of its related entities; (iii) you are a chairperson, council member, Executive Director, President, CEO, General Manager, or serve in any other capacity where significant discretionary authority is exercised, for the Sitka Tribe of Alaska; or (iv) within the past seven (7) years you have been bankrupt, insolvent, had a receiver appointed for you, or been found guilty of a criminal offense (other than traffic violations or other minor offenses).
- Class A Shareholders who desire to have their name appear as a candidate in SAI's election materials must comply with all requirements set forth in this packet and SAI's Bylaws and must submit all

materials to SAI so they are received on or before 5:00 p.m. local Sitka, AK time on February 26, 2021.

- There will be no charge to any candidate for the inclusion of his or her information in SAI's election materials. A candidate is responsible for all other expenses of their candidacy.
- The State of Alaska has rules and regulations that apply to all candidates who run for election as a director of an ANCSA corporation. You can find a discussion of the applicable State of Alaska rules at the State of Alaska website concerning ANCSA corporations at https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/dbs/ancsa.aspx and specifically in the booklet available from the State of Alaska through a link at such website entitled INFORMATION FOR SHAREHOLDERS OF ANCSA CORPORATIONS.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

Under SAI's election procedures, qualified Class A shareholders who want to be considered for selection as a candidate and who want to have their information included in SAI's proxy statement and on SAI's corporate proxy must submit the following information.

All candidates must submit:

- 1. your resume, which should include employment, education and other matters you consider significant,
- 2. Attachment A: Application and Disclosure Statement,
- 3. Attachment B: Personal Statement (in Word) and include optional digital photo for proxy statement
- 4. Attachment C: Consent to Background Check and Usage
- 5. Attachment D: Candidate Questions
- 6. Attachment E: Candidate Agreement

ATTACHMENT A: APPLICATION AND DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

All candidates must complete and sign Attachment A: the Application and Disclosure Statement. This will help SAI prepare appropriate initial disclosures about the candidates that are included in the SAI proxy statement and on SAI's corporate proxy.

Note: A candidate is responsible for his or her own disclosures and compliance with State of Alaska rules including filings with the State if the candidate uses any materials other than SAI's proxy and proxy statement to solicit proxies. You can find a discussion of the applicable State of Alaska rules at the State of Alaska website concerning ANCSA corporations at https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/dbs/ancsa.aspx and specifically in the booklet available from the State of Alaska through a link at such website entitled INFORMATION FOR SHAREHOLDERS OF ANCSA CORPORATIONS.

ATTACHMENT B: PERSONAL STATEMENT and optional digital photo

All candidates must provide a Personal Statement (Attachment B) in MS Word format. This allows you to set forth your biographical information and personal campaign statement, subject to such revisions as SAI deems necessary to comply with legal requirements and space limitations.

In addition, you may also submit a high-resolution digital photograph of yourself in electronic format, which may be included in SAI's proxy statement if it complies with printing and formatting requirements. Submission of a photograph is optional.

ATTACHMENT C: CONSENT TO BACKGROUND CHECK AND USAGE

All candidates must submit a signed Consent to Background Check and Usage (Attachment C). Failure to submit the Consent to Background Check and Usage will cause your application to be rejected and you will not be permitted to appear on SAI's corporate proxy or in SAI's proxy materials in any manner.

ATTACHMENT D: CANDIDATE QUESTIONS

All candidates must complete and sign Attachment D: the questionnaire.

ATTACHMENT E: CANDIDATE AGREEMENT

Date

All candidates must submit a signed Candidate Agreement (Attachment E). The Candidate Agreement states your agreement and understanding that you will: 1) abide by all State statutes and regulations governing proxy solicitation; and 2) comply with all SAI rules, bylaws and directives concerning elections. If you are not selected as a candidate, or do not want to appear in SAI's election materials as a candidate, the Candidate Agreement will no longer apply, and you are able to run as an Independent Candidate.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs) ABOUT SAI'S DIRECTOR ELECTION PROCESS

How do I run for election to the SAI Board at an annual meeting?

There are 2 ways to run for election to the SAI Board at an annual meeting: 1) as a candidate on the corporate proxy or 2) as an Independent Candidate on your own proxy.

Do I have to be a Class A shareholder to run for the Board? Yes. Are there other requirements to run for the Board? Yes.

You cannot run for the Board if (i) you are an officer or director of another ANCSA corporation; (ii) you are an employee or paid consultant of Shee Atiká, Incorporated or one of its related entities; (iii) you are a chairperson, council member, Executive Director, President, CEO, General Manager, or serve in any other capacity where significant discretionary authority is exercised, for the Sitka Tribe of Alaska; or (iv) within the past seven (7) years you have been bankrupt, insolvent, had a receiver appointed for you, or been found guilty of a criminal offense (other than traffic violations or other minor offenses).

How do I become a candidate for election to the SAI Board?

Each year the Board requests applications from shareholders interested in applying to run as a candidate on the corporate proxy. Interested Class A shareholders must submit a completed application including all required materials by the stated deadline.

Is running on the corporate proxy the same as running as an "Independent Candidate" on my own proxy?

No. When you run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, your name will appear on the corporate proxy. SAI will prepare, mail and file the proxy materials, including your information, without any cost to you. Since the corporate proxy materials are sent to every SAI shareholder that holds Class A stock, every shareholder will get a chance to vote for you when they fill out the corporate proxy. As a part of this process, SAI will file all of the corporate proxy materials with the State of Alaska. If you solicit proxies on your own, you are responsible for filing all of your solicitations with the State of Alaska.

When you run as an Independent Candidate, your name does not appear on the corporate proxy and you will be responsible for the cost of preparing and mailing your proxy materials to shareholders. Since Alaska law requires that every candidate prepare a proxy statement, you will be required to prepare a proxy statement that complies with Alaska law and to mail this proxy statement along with your proxy and any other proxy materials to shareholders. Also, Alaska law requires that proxy materials be filed with the State of Alaska at the same time (or before) you begin your distribution to shareholders.

Can I run both as a candidate on the corporate proxy and as an Independent Candidate?

No. Before you are allowed to run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, you must sign an agreement with the corporation that prohibits you from running at the same time as an Independent candidate.

If I run as an Independent candidate, will SAI pay my expenses such as travel or the costs of mailing to shareholders, or will SAI prepare my proxy statement, my proxy or any other proxy materials for me? No.

If I run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, will SAI provide me with additional corporate proxies? Yes. You must use the exact form of the corporate proxy, without any changes.

If I run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, will SAI pay my expenses?

If you comply with all rules, SAI will include your name and description in the corporate proxy statement and on the corporate proxy as a candidate. SAI will then mail the corporate proxy and proxy statement to all shareholders at SAI's expense. Any other expenses (including any subsequent mailings that you wish to make and any travel and hotel expenses) will be at your own expense.

How do I become a candidate for election to the SAI Board?

Class A shareholders who want to appear as a candidate must submit a completed application (indicating your wish to be included as a candidate in Part A of the Application and Disclosure Statement) and all required materials including a signed Candidate Agreement (Attachment E). Candidates must also comply with SAI's Bylaws, the rules and directives of SAI and the laws of the State of Alaska.

If I run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, do I have to provide SAI with copies of my advertising and other campaign materials before I use them?

Yes. You are also required to make any changes requested by SAI before you use them.

If I run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, will SAI's proxyholders use any of the corporation's discretionary votes to vote for me? No, there will not be a discretionary voting option on the 2021 corporate proxy.

If I run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, will SAI's proxyholders use any of the votes directed to me to vote for anyone else? No.

What is the cross-out power and does it apply to my candidacy?

Alaska law requires that shareholders be given a right to cross out any candidate that a shareholder does not want proxyholders to vote for using that shareholder's proxy. It applies to all proxies.

Are there rules and regulations that apply to my candidacy?

Any candidate for election to the SAI Board, regardless of whether they are a candidate on the corporate proxy or an Independent candidate, must comply with all Alaska state laws, regulations and rules and SAI's Bylaws.

specifically in the booklet available from the State of Alaska through a link at such website entitled *INFORMATION FOR SHAREHOLDERS OF ANCSA CORPORATIONS*.

If you are running as a candidate on the corporate proxy, you are also required to comply with the Candidate Agreement that you have signed and also with all directives issued by SAI concerning the conduct of your campaign.

If I run as a candidate on the corporate proxy or as an Independent candidate, can I get a list of SAI shareholders that are eligible to vote at the meeting?

Upon advance written request, SAI will allow a candidate on the corporate proxy or an Independent candidate to inspect and copy the record list of shareholders for the meeting.

As an alternative to actually inspecting the record mailing list and making their own copy of that list, a candidate on the corporate proxy or an Independent candidate may make a written request for a written or electronic copy of the record list. Upon payment of a fee set by SAI, SAI will provide a written or electronic copy of the record list. The record list is not a set of mailing labels and candidates will need to prepare their own set of mailing labels based on the record list.

Candidates are advised that it may take a few days for the SAI office to prepare the record list from SAI's shareholder data base. This is because the shareholder database contains personal and private data relative to shareholders, which must be deleted before the record list can be provided to candidates.

If I run as a candidate on the corporate proxy, do I have to make any filings with the State of Alaska?

If your ONLY campaign materials are SAI's proxy and proxy statement, no filing is required because SAI will file these with the State.

However, if you use any other materials, you must first provide those other materials to SAI. Then after SAI approves the other materials, you then must file such other materials with the State at the same time (or before) that you send them or otherwise make the materials available to shareholders. This includes any materials that you make available through the Internet, such as by email, texting or with any social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.) postings.

How do I file materials?

You are allowed to file your materials in a paper format, or a digital media format (CD or DVD), or electronically. If materials are filed in a paper format or a digital media format, you are required to send two copies to the following address:
